Every Saturday in September we will be having fresh bread, jams, and other baked items for sale by locals!!! Come satisfy your sweet tooth with these delectable treats!!



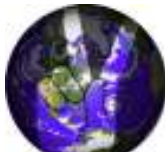
Attention Artists

International Day of Peace

September 21st, 2014

- **The Stage Stop Arts and Crafts Center** is hosting an Art Contest for kids. The art contest will consist of an original theme incorporating Peace. Participants can use a variety of mediums, including charcoal, crayon, pencil and paint to express the theme. The works created are unique and express the artists' life experience and culture. Each poster is judged on originality, artistic merit and expression of the theme.
- **Contest Rules:** Contest is open to students who are between the ages of 5 and 18. Artwork must not be smaller than 8x11 inches and no larger than 20x24 inches. Only one entry per student. All artwork must be the individual student's original creation. All media are accepted. All artist signatures or initials should be written on the back of the poster.
- **Judges:** Judges will be the Mayor, and Council Members.
- Submit art work no later than **September 12, 2014**. Please submit all artwork to the Town Hall.
- Art work will be displayed at the Art Center and Community Center. **The winners will be announced at the Fall Harvest Festival September 20, 2014.**
