MEETING CALLED TO ORDER at 7:00 PM

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

ROLL CALL:

Mayor Redding, Councilperson Schirmer, Councilperson Cronk, Councilperson Marlatt, Councilperson Burns were present.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Under New Business: Quill, Mayor Redding added "Using Platte County businesses for Town supplies." Councilperson Cronk made a motion that the Agenda be approved. Councilperson Burns seconded the motion. Motion Passed.

APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES:

Motion made by Councilperson Marlatt to accept April 1, 2019 Town Council meeting minutes and April 22, 2019 Special Meeting minutes and seconded by Councilperson Cronk. Motion passed.

Appointment: Lance Wedemeyer as Chugwater Town Maintenance Man. Motion made by Councilperson Schirmer to approve the appointment of Lance as Town Maintenance Man. Seconded by Councilperson Cronk. Motion passed.

OLD BUSINESS:

City Attorney Jones report on the contract between Banner and Town of Chugwater regarding the Ambulance/First Responder. City Attorney Jones reported that Banner had questions about insurance coverage from the town which he had responded with coverages.

Postage machine, it was decided that stamps would continue to be used in the future.

NEW BUSINESS:

Todd Bishop presented the four bids that were received from the banks in regards to the six penny tax bonds. Motion was made by Councilperson Marlatt to accept the bid from Wyoming Bank and Trust for the bonds. Second was made by Councilperson Schirmer. Motion passed. A motion was made by Councilperson Burns to approve the resolution allowing Mayor Redding to sign the documents on behalf of the Chugwater Town Council. Councilperson Cronk seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Propane Contract- Councilman Burns made a motion to accept the propane contract from Frenchman Valley. The Town agreed to purchase 2500 gallons at \$1.44/ gallon. Last year the Town used 2300 gallons of propane. If the Town requested a summer fill it would cost \$1.34/gallon.

Town Spring Cleanup- Town decided to have TDS provide roll off dumpsters for cleanup. Originally the dates would have been May 30th through June 1st. Now the dates are June 6th through the 8th. Residents will need to bring their water bill in order to place items in the dumpsters.

4-River-It was decided to put off purchasing a full cab and blade for the new tractor till this fall.

Quill- Mayor Redding stated that she would like to start using Quill to order supplies for Town use. Also, would like to start using businesses in Platte County rather than those in Cheyenne.

Xerox-Council decided to see what Capital had to offer in the way of copiers/printer/scanner/fax. Compare Capital's proposal against Xerox.

Kim McBryant requested a 24 hour liquor license for the Chugwater Chili Cook Off. Councilperson Marlatt made the motion to approve the 24 hour liquor license. Councilman Schirmer made the second. Motion passed.

Approval of the Bills

Motion made by Councilperson Cronk to approve bills .Second by Councilperson Burns. Motion passed.
