November 02, 2020**

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER at 19:00

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

ROLL CALL:

Councilperson Schirmer, Councilperson Burns, Mayor Redding, Councilperson Marlatt were present. Councilperson Cronk was absent.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Councilperson Marlatt made a motion that the Agenda be approved. Councilperson Burns seconded the motion. Motion Passed.

APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES:

Motion made by Councilperson Schirmer to accept October 06, 2020 Town Council meeting minutes. Councilperson Marlatt seconded the motion. Motion passed. Councilperson Burns abstained due to the fact he was absent for the October 06, 2020 Town Council Meeting.

REPORTS:

1. Director of Water and Sewer Report-~ 7 inches of snow.
2. Treasurer's Report- Council wants to see shortened version of balance sheet.

OLD BUSINESS:

Third reading of the Water Ordinance 312- Councilperson Burns made a motion that the third reading of Water Ordinance 312 be approved. Councilperson Schirmer seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Council was asked if they wanted to start setting aside funds for water and sewer replacement. Council decided to open a bank account at BOTW in the amount of \$2,000.00 which is coming from the general fund. This will be on a quarterly basis and the amount will be determined each quarter by council. Councilperson Marlatt made the motion. Councilperson Schirmer seconded the motion. Motion passed.

City Attorney Jones is going to file a claim in circuit court against Cathy Sauzo in the amount of \$114.45 for outstanding WTS.

City Attorney Jones up dated the lease agreement for those individuals who wish to rent office space at the business building. He will email the final agreement to the clerk when finished.

Council decided to keep the roof bid specs separate for the museum roof and the other town owned property. Coby will finish up the bid specs for the town property and the clerk will send the estimate to him for the museum roof repairs that Capital Roofing presented to Council several months ago.

Council decided to pursue legal action against Ted Kranenberg to get reimbursed in the amount of \$810.00 for the cost of repairing the street on 5th. Councilperson Marlatt made the motion. Councilperson Schirmer seconded the motion.

NEW BUSINESS:

Liquor License Renewal:

Councilperson Marlatt made a motion that the Chugwater Soda Fountain Liquor license be renewed. Councilperson Burns seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Councilperson Schirmer made a motion that the Stampede Saloon and Eatery Liquor license be renewed. Councilperson Marlatt seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Councilperson Burns made a motion that the Buffalo Lodge & Grill Liquor license be renewed. Councilperson Schirmer seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Philip Ellis:

CHUG signed a resolution accepting the donation from the Baker family to repair the roof on the museum.

School buildings: People would still like to see the gym kept open.

Ambulance vehicle: Council decided to advertise the ambulance for sale through the bid process. The proceeds from the sale will be used to purchase a pickup for town use saving the 1-Ton for snow plowing. Councilperson Burns made a motion. Councilperson Schirmer seconded the motion.

Upgrading the Town Hall and Town Shop to fiber optics: After discussion Council tabled the idea until more information could be obtained.
