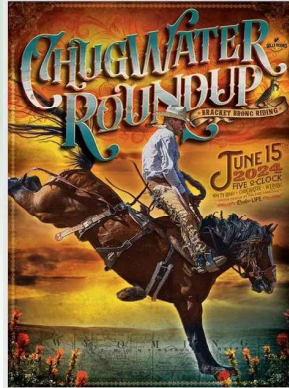
### CHUGWATER CHILI CORPORATION
